Margrit Linck is regarded as one of Switzerland's premier ceramic artists. Her multifaceted creative legacy is kept alive today through the Linck Ceramics manufactory and continues to inspire contemporary artisans. Drawing on an extensive collection of patterns and draft designs by Margrit Linck, the studio in Worblaufen (Bern) produces ceramics for everyday use by hand using traditional craftsmanship. Under the direction of Annet Berger, the Linck team also develops its own color concepts for individual forms while exploring a contemporary perspective on her oeuvre in cooperation with designers, artists, and photographers.

For the Circle of Friends edition and as part of the exhibition "Margrit Linck, Pioneer of Ceramics," the spherical vase has been lovingly recreated with a slip in a delicate pastel shade of blue as a tribute to Margrit Linck's beginnings. The soft brushstrokes demonstrate the fine craftsmanship involved in creating each unique piece.
