Trix (b. 1933) and Robert (b. 1931) Haussmann are architects and designers best known for their "critical Mannerism." The Stripes Buffet Plate, designed in 1985, shows how a silk scarf can be transformed by chance and artistic draping into an illusionistic porcelain pattern. The first version was created for the New York tableware producer Swid Powell, and in 2017 the Circle of Friends of the Museum für Gestaltung Zürich launched a new version of the buffet plate, taking it from the museum to the table.
